## GUIDELINES BEFORE ENROLLMENT

Please read the following guidelines before enrolling in the LIVE online class.

1. **Requirements by participant**
  - Working laptop/desktop.
  - Stable Internet connection with Minimum bandwidth of 600kbps (up/down) and recommended is 1.5 Mbps (up/down). Check your Internet bandwidth using <https://www.fast.com>.
  - Zoom app for Windows/Mac installed in your laptop/desktop.
  - Working microphone (optional).
  - Working webcam (optional).
  - Adobe Photoshop installed in your laptop/desktop. You will be instructed on how to do this in the first class.
  - Working knowledge of Windows or Mac.
  - Working email address.

## 2. Photoshop Software

Adobe Photoshop will NOT be provided by St. Anthony's College. Participants may download and install the fully functioning trial version of Adobe Photoshop using the following link <https://www.adobe.com/in/creativecloud/catalog/desktop.html>. The instructor will guide you in installation of Photoshop in the first class.

## 3. LIVE

The Photoshop online classes will be live and not pre-recorded.

## 4. Queries during online classes

All doubts and questions can be sent live via Zoom chat at the end each class session or emailed to [photoshop@anthony.ac.in](mailto:photoshop@anthony.ac.in). Further instructions will be given by the resource person.

## 5. Recording

All online live classes will be recorded and sent to the participants after each class.

## 6. Secure, Private and Safe

- All classes will be conducted LIVE online.
- All participants will be provided a secure link and password for each online class.
- The entire process from enrollment to receiving of certificate will be conducted online. There will be no need to visit St. Anthony's College campus.
- The LIVE online class will be in Zoom's webinar format. You as a participant **will not be seen (video) or heard (audio) by other participants**. Other participants will not be able to send private chats to you.
