ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN FISHERY SCIENCE

Application on plain paper along with CV (mentioning contact number and email ID) with copies of supporting mark sheets, certificates, documents, publications etc. are invited for the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of Fishery Science.

Essential Qualifications:

1. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (General candidates) and 50% (SC/ST candidates) or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading is followed at the Master's Degree level in M.Sc. (Fisheries)/ M. F. Sc. from an recognized University.
2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
3. Candidates who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree with specialization with M.Sc.(Fisheries)/M.F.Sc., in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of PhD Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for requirement.

Desirable:

1. Candidates who have had a teaching/working experience in fisheries will be preferred.

Attested copies of all relevant documents, certificates and publications (if any) need to be submitted along with the application.

The in-service candidates should apply through Proper channel.
